Summary	<p>The Ministry of Minority Affairs has tasked the Centre for Advanced Studies Research & Development (CASRD) unit of Delhi School of Professional Studies & Research (DPSR), Rohini, Delhi - 110085, an affiliated college of G.G.S. Indraprastha University, Dwarka, New Delhi, with informing minorities about the welfare programmes being run for minorities by the Ministry of Minority Affairs. The Ministry of Minority Affairs recognizes Christians, Sikhs, Boudhs, Parsis, Jains, and Muslims as belonging to minority communities. In light of this, the Ministry of Minority Affairs organises important initiatives like Nai Roshni, Learn & Earn, Padho Pardesh, USTTAD, etc., through which trainees from the aforementioned minority communities receive financial aid in the form of loans, grants, and scholarships for study both domestically and abroad. The Ministry also offers loans to minorities at extraordinarily low interest rates for the purpose of helping them launch small businesses. The terms and conditions under which the loans must be repaid are likewise extremely flexible. A two-day conference was planned for the 28th and 29th of December 2019 at BRDBD Degree College Ashram Barhaj, Deoria, Barhaj, Uttar Pradesh-274601, with the goal of enhancing minority community members' awareness, comprehension, and knowledge of the numerous programmes run by the Ministry of Minority Affairs. The Conference, which is being hosted by the Delhi School of Professional Studies & Research (DPSR), Rohini, Delhi, under the sponsorship of the Centre for Advanced Studies Research & Development (CASRD), will also be centred on the initiatives the state of Uttar Pradesh's government provides for the state's minorities.</p>
