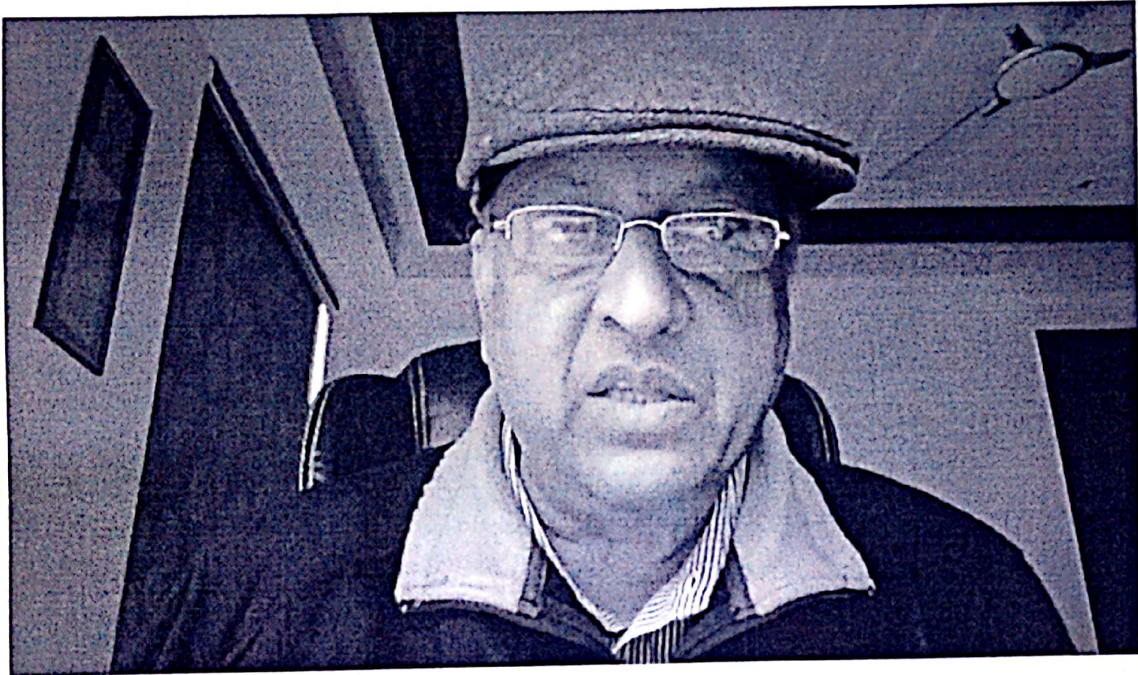

Bhanumurthy, Professor of Economics, Delhi Technological University & Former Head and Dean, Faculty of Commerce and Business Department of Commerce, Delhi School of Economics, University of Delhi, Delhi; Dr. Shyam Singh Inda, Assistant Advisor, NAAC, Bangalore; Dr. Rajesh Khajuria, Commissioner on Board - ACBSP USA, Director and Professor, CKSVIM Business School</p> <p>The speakers highlighted that the objective of HEI should be continuous quality improvement and it should not be the sole responsibility of the IQAC coordinator but multiple support systems to be provided to the IQAC team.</p> <p>They focused on the role of the IQAC coordinator that there should be a rotation of the IQAC coordinator and second in command should be inducted simultaneously as it will help in better succession planning as well. Moreover, the head of the institution should be more involved in the whole process of IQAC as they have more knowledge. It was also mentioned that online education has been a boon as well in some cases wherein it has given vent to the creativity and innovation of some teachers.</p> |
