<b>Summary</b>	<p>The Ministry of Minority Affairs has assigned the Centre for Advanced Studies Research &amp; Development (CASRD) unit of Delhi School of Professional Studies &amp; Research (DPSR), Rohini, Delhi - 110085, an affiliated college of G.G.S. Indraprastha University, Dwarka, New Delhi, with the task of enlightening minorities about the welfare programmes being run for minorities by the Ministry of Minority Affairs. Muslims, Sikhs, Jains, Boudhs, Parsis, and Christians are considered members of minority communities according to the Ministry of Minority Affairs. For the aforementioned reason, the Ministry of Minority Affairs runs major programmes like Nai Roshni, Learn &amp; Earn, Padho Pardesh, USTTAD, etc., under which trainees from the above- mentioned minority communities are given financial aid in the form of loans, grants, and scholarships for study abroad and in India. The Ministry also assists minorities in starting small enterprises, for which minorities are given loans at extremely low interest rates and are required to return the loans in accordance with highly lenient terms and conditions. A two-day conference was scheduled for 7<sup>th</sup> &amp; 8<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 at Doon University, Dehradun, Uttarakhand in order to increase awareness, understanding, and knowledge about the various programmes of the Ministry of Minority Affairs for the benefit of minority community members. The Conference, which is being held by the Delhi School of Professional Studies &amp; Research (DPSR), Rohini, Delhi, under the auspices of the Centre for Advanced Studies Research &amp; Development (CASRD), will also focus on the programmes the Uttrakhand Government offers for the state's minorities.</p>
