Summary	Delhi School of Professional Studies and Research (an affiliated college of Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University, Delhi; & a NAAC accredited 'A' Grade Institution) organized its Twenty Fourth Annual International Seminar on the broad theme "Governance, Institutions and Justice" on June 4-5, 2022 under the joint auspices of Elsevier, Indian commerce Association Delhi-NCR chapter; Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee Govt. Arts and Commerce College, Indore; Rotary Club of Delhi Maurya; and Divine

International Group of Institutions, Gwalior.

More than 250 academicians, researchers, students, and practicing managers both from India and abroad participated over the two-days spread, punctuated by inaugural and valedictory sessions. 42 papers were presented across the two days of the conference representing countries, namely, Bangladesh, Oman, Malaysia, South Africa, Philippines, Vietnam, Nepal and India.

The Pre-Seminar workshop on the topic, "How to find quality content using Science Direct" in collaboration with Elsevier was held on June 03, 2022. The speaker of the workshop, Ms. Aishwarya Nayal, Customer Consultant, Elsevier talked about identifying and understanding research issues, research & publishing workflow. She, also, spoke about how to effectively use ScienceDirect to search and download relevant articles. The seminar concluded with a live demonstration of what was theoretically explained during the seminar.

Singh, Secretary General, Organizing Committee - delivered the welcome note and elucidated the audience about the theme of the seminar; and Prof. Sima Kumari, Director, Delhi School of Professional Studies and Research – extended vote of thanks.

The honoured speakers touched upon the various aspects including the problems associated with rule of law, accessibility to quality education, environmental sustainability and global injustice prevalent in the world. The discussion explained the differentiating point between successful and failing nations, and challenges associated with inequality. The speakers also touched upon rapid digitalisation and its impact on the increase in cyber crime. Views were also exchanged over how Governments, civil societies and communities must work together to implement lasting solutions to reduce violence, deliver justice, combat corruption and ensure inclusive participation at all times.

Apart from the broad theme, the Technical Sessions were categorized into following sub-themes:

1. Institutions and Governance: Changing Paradigms
