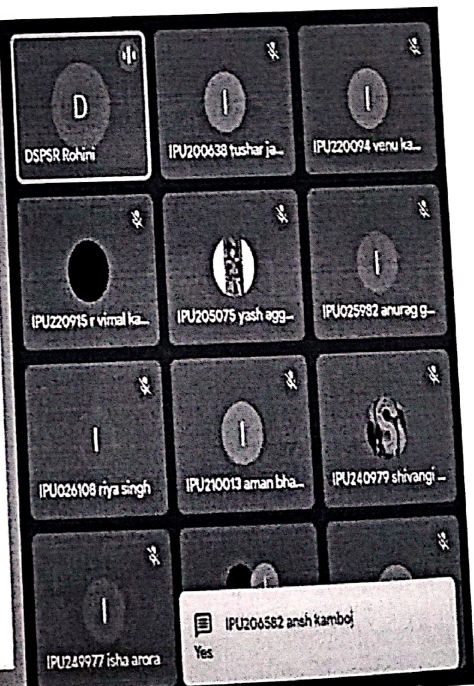
Top Public Speaking Skills
