It's a statement that includes your skills, abilities, experience, and what qualifies you for the position. Experience. Your work history is the most important component of your resume. Employers will want to know where you have worked, when you worked there, and what responsibilities you held in each role

A resume is to give your potential employer a feel for your past experience and skills. Remember you are trying to sell yourself, so emphasize your strengths. Most employers look for a steady job history and positive patterns of progression (i.e. increased responsibility, promotions).
