#### XVII ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR

elhi School of Professional Studies and Research organized and hosted XVII Annual International Seminar and II<sup>nd</sup> Annual Conference of IAMD on the theme, "Make in India: the road ahead" on 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> January, 2016 at India Habitat Centre, New Delhi. The international seminar was organized under the joint auspices of Indian Association of Management Development (IAMD); Sri Aurobindo College (Evening), University of Delhi; Divine International group of Institution, Gwalior and Rotary Club of Delhi, Maurya. The International Seminar was sponsored by Indian Council of Social Science Research, (ICSSR).



Dr. Swami Parthasarathy, Pro Chairman, United Nations Organisation for Economic Corporation and Development (UNOECD), Asia Pacific Zone, Manila, Philippines graced the seminar as the chief guest.


#### FDP AT DSPSR
