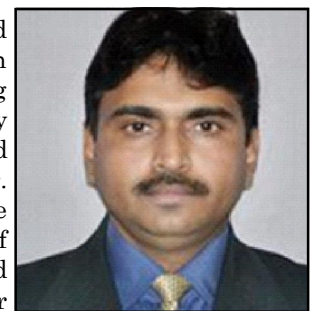
*Mrs. Monika Gulia*
