XX ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

The Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) sponsored Twentieth Annual International Conference on the broad theme “Global Vision 2030: Challenges and Opportunities” held on January 4-5, 2019 was organized by Delhi School of Professional Studies and Research (NAAC Accredited ‘A’ Grade Institution), under the joint auspices of DeenDayalUpadhyaya College, University of Delhi, Delhi; Shyam Lal College (Evening), University of Delhi; Sri Aurobindo College (Evening), University of Delhi; and Rotary Club of Delhi Maurya.

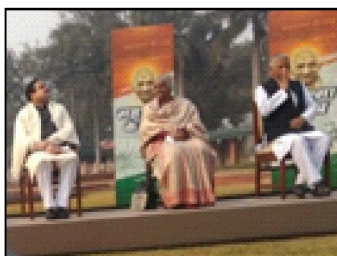
ANUGOONJ

Delhi School of Professional Studies and Research (DSPSR) organized a one-day MDP on the topic “Finance for Managers” in the college premises on February 23, 2019.

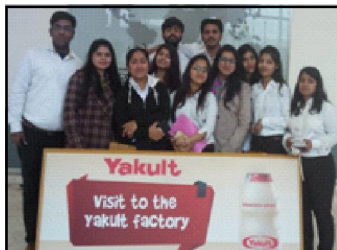
