They learnt a great deal about Supply Chain Management (SCM), Production Process and all the activities which are undertaken for Production of a Shoe/Slipper.



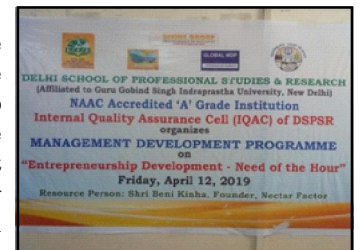
A brief outline of the company and key take-away points of the Industrial Visit are given below:

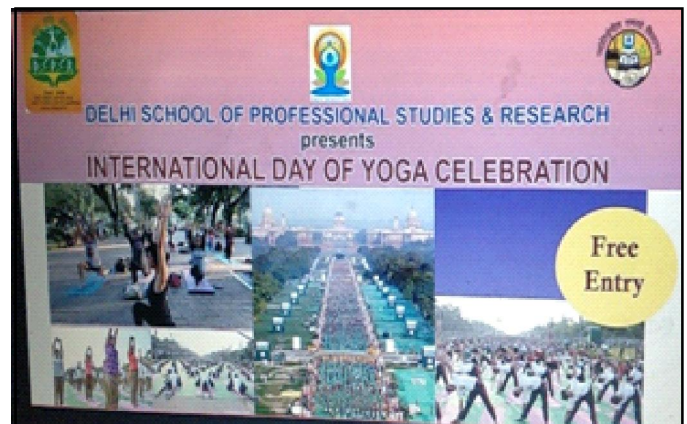
