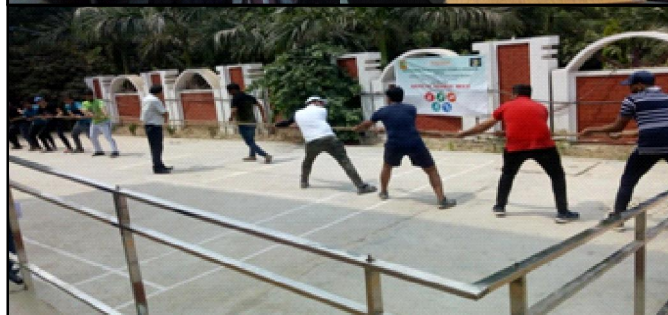
Members were encouraged to donate their books for a noble

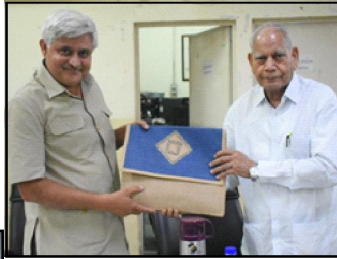

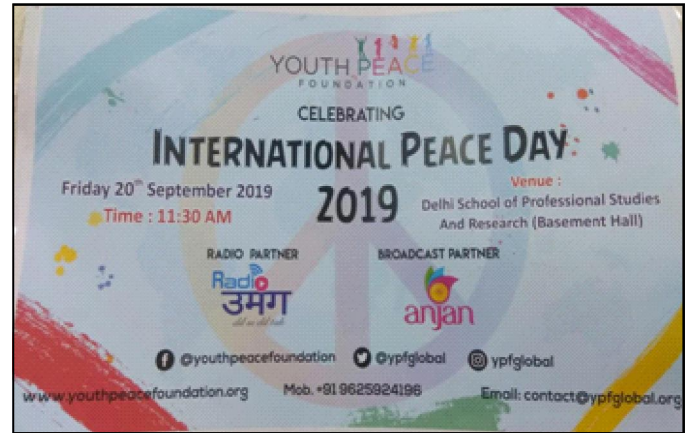
